		Müller (1805-1898) was a Christian missionary evangelist and a	
		coordinator of orphanages in Bristol, England. Through his faith	
		and prayers (and without asking for money) he had the privilege	
		of caring for over 120,000 orphan children. In his journals, Müller	
		recorded tales of God's provision and answered prayer:	
		One morning, all the plates and cups and bowls on the table	
		were empty. There was no food in the larder and no money to	
		buy food. The children were standing, waiting for their morning	
		meal, when Müller said, "Children, you know we must be in	
		time for school." Then lifting up his hands he prayed, "Dear	
		Father, we thank Thee for what Thou art going to give us to eat."	
		There was a knock at the door. The baker stood there, and said,	
		"Mr. Müller, I couldn't sleep last night. Somehow I felt you	
		didn't have bread for breakfast, and the Lord wanted me to	
		send you some. So I got up at 2 a.m. and baked some fresh	
		bread, and have brought it."
