Taking care of God's creation for future generations

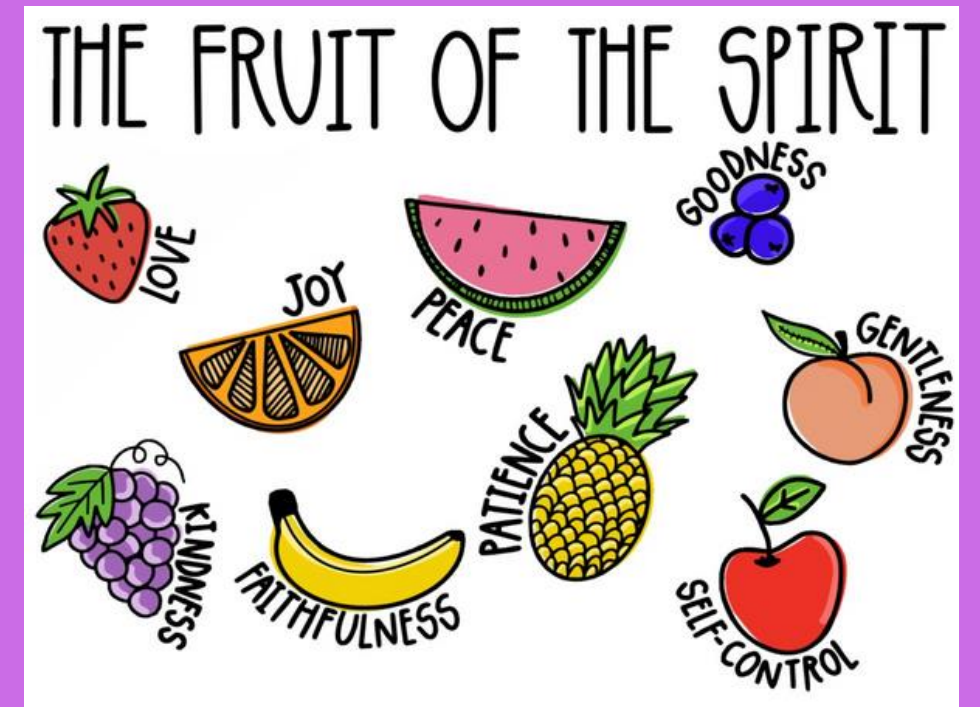
You first, me last.

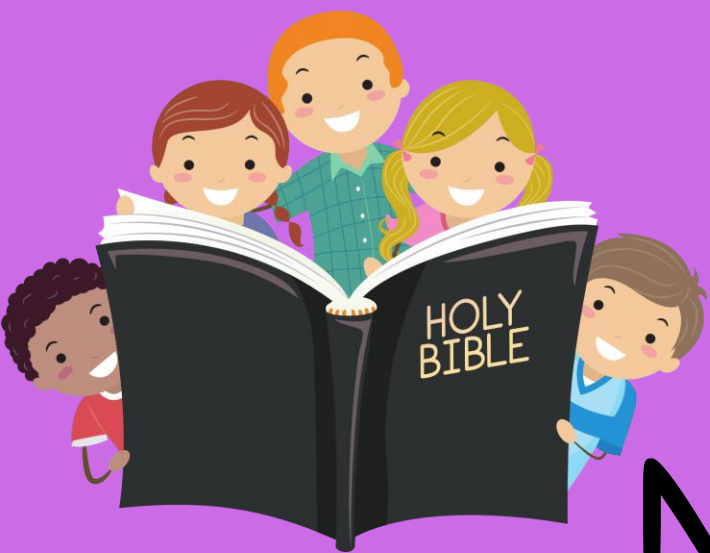
